<p>MOBILE DEVICES</p>	<p>Mobile devices brought into school are entirely at the staff member, student, parents or visitors own risk. <p>SUPERVISION</p>	<p><u>Supervision before and after School</u> Parents need to be aware that although pupils are allowed to enter the School after 7.30am, and remain in the canteen before 8am. There is no staff supervision guaranteed at these times. Pupils remaining after School must attend a regulated activity, including the H/W club. Unsupervised students need to be off site by 4.30pm. A letter will come out to parents in the autumn term with regards to the exact arrangements for after-school care.</p>
<p>SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND PROHIBITED ITEMS</p>	<p><u>Substance Abuse Policy</u> You are reminded that the School's policy is a strong one: anyone found to be knowingly in possession of an illegal substance (such as cannabis) while on the School premises, during journeys to and from School, or while involved in any School activity, can expect to be permanently excluded. http://www.qmgs.walsall.sch.uk/_content/policies/2016_substance_abuse_policy_may.pdf Such a strong line can also be expected in relation to other prohibited items (as set out on p6 of the School's Behaviour policy)</p>
<p>LEAVE OF ABSENCE</p>	<p><u>Leave of absence</u> If your son/daughter needs to miss School for something unavoidable (such as a music exam or a dental appointment that cannot be scheduled for after School), a formal request for leave of absence should be addressed to the Head of School giving as much notice as possible, or preferably three working days in advance. Please note that leave will not be granted for holidays unless there are clearly exceptional circumstances. Parents must seek permission from the Head of School for leave of absence related to religious observance, using the form available on the school website http://www.qmgs.walsall.sch.uk/_content/letters/2017_march_religious_observance.pdf Pupils must not arrange collection with their mobile phone. All contact with parents regarding pupils leaving the site must be through reception. <u>Pupils in Y7 – Y11 will not be allowed out of School unless their parents sign them out in the Exeat Book.</u> Your co-operation in this matter is much appreciated.</p>
<p>CARS - HEALTH AND SAFETY</p>	<p><u>Health and Safety</u> For reasons of Health and Safety, parents should not drive into the School grounds in the morning or before 5pm in the afternoon (6pm on Friday). Please be considerate of others in the Sutton Road, and residents in the surrounding area. Please do not do U-turns in the road, double park, block driveways or ignore the safety marking near the school gates. <u>6th Form Parking</u> Pupils driving to School are to park ONLY on the Sutton Road in the marked parking areas prepared especially for this purpose, and not in surrounding roads. Please note that pupils driving to school are not allowed to carry other pupils as passengers.</p>
