Senior Games Option – Off-Site Activities

With the number of students in the sixth form, it is impossible to provide guided games options for all. Many will represent the School in various teams, but each year a number opt to pursue activities out of school during Wednesday afternoon games lessons. There are, however, several matters to be considered by both parents and pupils before such a decision is taken:

- The activity must be of benefit to the pupil's health and fitness and be acceptable to the P.E. Department.
- Pupils may only leave school following afternoon registration in the afternoon in order to attend off-site activities (using the sign out procedures)
- Pupils are responsible for making their own transport arrangements.
- Any costs involved are to be met by the pupil.
- The minimum period of participation in an off-site activity is one term. (Options can be changed each term).
- Off -site activities will not be supervised by Staff.
- Pupils should be aware that spot checks may be made by members of Staff.
