The History Department is running a trip to the Imperial War Museum in Manchester on November 16th and 17th. 9A and D will have the chance to visit the museum on Thursday 16th with 9G and P visiting on Friday 17th.

The visit will offer an excellent opportunity for the boys to consolidate and extend their Year 9 learning, as well as provide potential GCSE Historians with an introduction to their Year 10 course.

The trip will run during school hours, departing at 9am and returning in time for the school buses. If there are any problems with our return time due to any travel impediments, your son will contact you. We therefore ask for you to be contactable after 2pm.

Students should bring their mobile phones with them and a small amount of money if they wish to buy a drink/snack. They should also bring a packed lunch and are required to wear uniform.
