Year 11 Revision Timetable and Study Leave Arrangements

All pupils in Y11 will follow their normal timetable until Friday, 12th May. From Monday, 15th May to Friday, 26th May, all pupils will remain in School and follow a revision timetable. They will be supervised in these revision lessons by members of the teaching staff. If your son does not have an exam or is not in a revision session, between these dates, he will be allowed to leave at 2.20pm

Study Leave will begin for the majority of Y11 pupils, on Monday 5th June, although there are some **compulsory** revision sessions when all will be expected to attend; other voluntary sessions will also be available to your son if he chooses to take advantage of these. However, there are a number of boys who will remain in School until Friday, 16th June for targeted support.

From Monday, 19th June all of Y11 will be on Study leave following book return which takes place on this day at 11.00am (Some pupils will be in School anyway on this day for a further maths examination in the morning.). Your son should bring any books and resources that he has used for his GCSE courses to School on this day to be collected in. It is important that a complete set should be returned so they can be re-allocated to another Year group. Thank you in anticipation of your assistance in this important matter.

Your son will be given a copy of the Revision Timetable when he returns from the Easter holiday so he should be fully aware of the arrangements. He will also know if he is one of those who should be in School until Friday, 16th June for extra revision.


All revision arrangements have been made to give the optimum level of support for your son. If he has been asked to stay for the extra week it is hoped that you will explain to him that this is for *his benefit* so that he can maximise his potential. It would also be helpful if you could ensure that your son attends any compulsory sessions that the School has made available.
