Study Leave for Y12 pupils

Study Leave for all Y12 pupils commences at 4.00pm on Friday, 12th May and continues until Friday, 2nd June. Pupils are not expected to be in School during this time unless, in exceptional circumstances, agreed with Mr Matley.

There may be some public examinations outside this period in which case pupils will be permitted to be absent during the morning if the exam is scheduled for the afternoon and the previous afternoon if the exam is in the morning. However, any pupils who have entered for these exams must inform their Group Tutor in advance of any absence so that the registers can be marked accordingly.


A level courses will recommence on Monday, 5th June and all pupils will be expected to be back in School on this day.

During Study Leave we expect members of the Year to honour commitments to school teams and extra-curricular activities. On all occasions when they come into school, they should wear full school uniform.

I should like to point out that Study Leave is a concession and not a right and it may be withdrawn if an individual's behaviour is unsatisfactory during the summer term.
