## Publication of GCSE Results

The results of the GCSE Examinations will be published on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2018**.

On that day candidates who wish to do so may collect their results from the School Office between 9.30am and 10.30am.

Results will be handed **ONLY** to the candidates. Results will **NOT** be issued to a third party without prior consent from candidate. Please contact Examination Office for further information. Results which have not been collected on the day will be retained in School.

As there will inevitably be large numbers of pedestrians on site, for safety reasons please park on Sutton Road and walk down the drive. Please resist the temptation to telephone the School.

If your child has failed to meet the minimum requirement for entry into the Sixth Form, a member of the Senior Leadership Team will be available to discuss next steps.


If it is a case of your child not getting the required grade in one or more of the subjects they have chosen to carry forward to A level, Mr Lax will be available to discuss other options on the day, or as soon as possible afterwards, in order to secure an alternative subject.

Candidates may see me immediately at school on 23<sup>rd</sup> August to discuss any problems or difficulties arising from the results or alternatively make an appointment to see me as soon as possible.

Following admission to the sixth form, which is confirmed in August, your child will be expected to attend a sixth form induction day on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2018. More information will be given following the publication of results on 23<sup>rd</sup> August.
