

LAMDA Tuition and Examinations 2026–2027

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to invite applications for LAMDA (London Academy of Music & Dramatic Art) tuition at Queen Mary's Grammar School for the 2026–2027 academic year.

LAMDA qualifications are internationally recognised and provide students with valuable opportunities to develop confidence, communication skills, creativity, and performance techniques. Please note, students DO NOT have to take an exam to sign up for these lessons. Exams are a small part of the journey. The aim is to develop confidence and oracy skills to support students with their next steps, such as interviews etc.

Students may choose to study in one of the following disciplines:

- Speaking in Public
- Speaking Verse and Prose
- Acting

Students in Years 7–10 typically work towards Grades 1–5, whilst students in Years 11–13 study at Grades 6–8. A significant advantage of the higher-level qualifications is that Grades 6–8 attract UCAS Tariff Points, making them an excellent addition to applications for higher education.

Lessons are delivered on a rolling timetable during the school day, ensuring that students do not repeatedly miss the same curriculum lessons. Tuition is available either individually or in shared lessons and consists of a 20-minute lesson each week for up to 8 weeks per term. **All students studying grades 6-8 are encouraged to have solo lessons.**

Lesson Fees (fees are payable by monthly direct debit)

- Solo lessons: £33.75 per month
- Shared lessons: £23.75 per month

Please note prices are not inclusive of LAMDA examination entry fees, which are payable directly to LAMDA. QMGS are committed to support students, so if your child is Pupil Premium, there may be support with the cost of these fees from the school.

We are extremely proud of our students' achievements. During the last academic year, **100% of our LAMDA candidates achieved Distinction grades** in their examinations, reflecting the commitment of both students and staff to maintaining exceptionally high standards.

Places for the 2026–2027 academic year are limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. We therefore encourage interested families to register their interest as soon as possible.
